Dear Fellow Citizen:

Enclosed you will find a marked ballot sent to you, as a suggestion, in assisting you in selecting, what we feel, will be the persons who will try to serve ALL citizens.

When you sign your name with the checkers inside the voting place, you will be given a paper ballot. On this ballot will be listed the names of ~~NINE~~ (9) CONGRESSMEN. You are asked to vote for EIGHT (8) out of this nine by marking and X with a pen. After making your choice you will place this paper ballot in the box provided for these ballots.

You will now go into the machine, as before, and vote for the following:

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Governor

Lieutenant Governor

Attorney General

And

Three Democratic Committeemen

You will vote for your choice by following the same procedure as before when using the voting machine (pulling the lever by the person of your choice).

Please remember, you must VOTE FOR EIGHT (8) out of the nine CONGRESSMEN on the paper ballot or your ballot will not count. Remember the name of the Congressman that you are not going to vote for and simply vote for the other eight. THIS IS MOST IMPORTANT.

If you need further advice, please check with one of the ladies/men that will be across the street or in the vicinity of the polls checking before you enter the polls and they will assist you.
