Vice Chairman Lewis reported on securing precinct maps for each committee member. After discussion it was voted that we spend the necessary money so as to provide each committee member with a precinct map.

Lieutenant Governor nominee Jere Beasley was present and made a short speech.

As there was no further business to come before the Committee, the Committee was adjourned.
