- Q. RESEARCH COMMITTEE TO PREPARE FACT SHEETS ON CURRENT ISSUES PRESENTING PRO AND CON ARGUMENTS. To::COMDUCT VOTING RECORD STUDIES ON MEMBERS OF CONGRESS AND STATISTICS ON PROSPECTS IN SEVERAL POLITICAL SECTIONS. TO SUMMARIZE INFORMATION IN LOCAL ISSUE CAMPAIGN MANUELS OR DATA SHEETS WHICH CAN PROVIDE FOR THE SPEAKER'S, PUBLICITY, AND LITERATURE COMMITTEES AND FOR THE RANK AND FILE ORGANIZATION WORKERS A USEFUL TOOL WITH WHICH THEY CAN BE KEPT INFORMED.
