## REPORT 53 NEGRO DELEGATES ASSIGNED TO COMMITTEES OF DEMOCRATIC CONVENTION

WASHINGTON, D. C. (Special) -- To date 53 Negro delegates have been assigned to various committees of the Democratic Convention, according to reports from the chairmen of delegations from 24 states, the District of Columbia, the Virgin Islands and the Canal Zone.

On the key Credentials Committee, headed by Governor Richard Hughes of New Jersey, 11 Negro delegates have been assigned thus far. The Credentials Committee will begin hearings on the contesting delegations in Chicago on Monday, August 19.

The total number of black delegates to the Democratic Convention is 313, with 177 listed as delegates and 136 as alternates. From the 11 states of the Old South there are 48 delegates and 57 alternates with Texas leading, listing six delegates and 11 alternates and Louisiana following, with nine delegates and four alternates.

Louis Martin, Democratic National Committee Deputy Chairman, pointed out that although Negro representation in 1968 is almost three times greater than in 1964, if any of the contesting delegations are seated at the Convention the total number of black delegates may be substantially increased.
