


SUMMARY OF BLACK CAUCUS ACTION

(July 11, 1972)

1. Have another Black Caucus at 2:00 p. m. Wednesday, July 12, at Fontainebleau Hotel (Fontaine Room)
2. Caucus is open to all Black people and they may all vote whether delegate, alternate or neither.
3. Caucus opposes all reports, resolutions, etc. supported by George Wallace and so should voting members
4. Steering Committee is authorized to act on behalf of the Caucus tonight with regard to McGovern's positions and commitments for Black people.
5. Arrangements were made for communications system between Black delegates and alternates on the convention floor. (See floor plan which designates location of communications post)
