CERTIFICATE OF INCORPORATION

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STATE OF ALABAMA :
COUNTY OF MONTGOMERY : 17361

The members of The Citizens' Club desiring to form a corporation under the Constitution and Laws of Alabama, the undersigned duly elected officers of said Club, for the purpose of becoming incorporated and entitled to the privileges of such corporations, and for the purposes hereinafter stated, do hereby declare as follows:

1. The name of the club is The Citizens' Club.

2. The objects and purposes of the club are the establishment of an organization and maintaining suitable club quarters for promoting the general social, civic, literary and cultural advancement and interest of its members as more particularly set out in the Constitution and By-Laws of The Citizens' Club.

3. A meeting of the members of The Citizens' Club was held in the City of Montgomery, Alabama, on the 3rd day of March, 1952, at the club rooms and quarters at 101 Nyles Street, at which meeting a constitution and by-laws were duly adopted, a true copy of which said constitution and by-laws is hereto attached, marked Exhibit "A".

4. The name, number, style and post office addresses of the officers elected at said meeting are as follows:

5. The name and addresses of the club members are as shown on a statement hereto attached and marked Exhibit "B".

6. The Citizens' Club does not issue shares of stock and is not for purposes of pecuniary gain, being entirely non-profit.

7. The constitution and by-laws of said club, a copy of which is attached hereto, marked Exhibit "A" contains statements with reference to keeping or disposing of prohibited liquors and with reference to games for wager as required by Sections 142 and 143, respectively, of Title 10 of the 1940 Code of Alabama.

8. Said club shall have all of the rights, privileges and powers incident to its general purposes and may do each and every thing suitable, necessary or proper for the accomplishment of any one or more of the objects and purposes herein set out which shall at any time appear conducive or expedient for the protection or

benefit of said corporation, and shall exercise and enjoy all of the powers, rights and franchises conferred upon corporations of its kind and character under and by virtue of the constitution and laws of the State of Alabama, it being the intention that the objects, purposes and powers specified herein, except where otherwise expressed herein, be in no wise limited or restricted by reference to or in reference from the terms of any other clause or any other paragraph in this instrument.

EXHIBIT "A"

CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS OF

THE CITIZENS' CLUB

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CONSTITUTION

PREAMBLE

For the purpose of promoting the social, civic and literary advancement and interest of its members, and the community, and for preserving and distributing statistics and information of value along these lines, The Citizens' Club is formed.

ARTICLE I

NAME

The name of this organization shall be The Citizens' Club.

ARTICLE II

MEMBERSHIP

Membership in the organization shall be open to all interested citizens who are voters or potential voters and are concerned with the social and civic development of our community and who comply with the requirements of the by-laws for membership.

ARTICLE III

OFFICERS

The officers of The Citizens' Club shall be the President, a Vice President, a Second Vice President, a Secretary and a Treasurer, no one person being permitted to hold more than one of said offices at one and the same time except that one person may fill both of the offices of Secretary and Treasurer. The officers shall each hold office for a period of one year from the date of their election, or until a successor is duly and legally elected and qualified.

ARTICLE IV

BOARD OF DIRECTORS

The government and direction of The Citizens' Club and the control of its property shall be vested in a Board of fifteen Directors, with each of the duly elected and qualified officers serving as one of these Directors, each of said Directors serving for a period of one year from the date of their election, or until a duly qualified successor is elected.

ARTICLE V

MEETINGS

Section 1. An annual meeting of the membership shall be held on the first Friday in May of each calendar year.

Section 2. The Board of Directors shall have power to fix the date and time of regular meetings but at least one regular meeting shall be held every three calendar months.

Section 3. Special meetings of The Citizens' Club, or of the Board of Directors, shall be called whenever deemed advisable by the Board of Directors or upon written request of ten members of this organization.

ARTICLE VI

The Citizens' Club shall have no right to engage in and will not engage in the business of selling, or keeping for sale, or otherwise disposing of any liquors, liquids or beverages that are prohibited by the laws of Alabama to be manufactured, sold or otherwise disposed of in this state, and shall not permit its membership to keep or store any such prohibited liquors or beverages at or near the premises of the corporation for use by or consumption by its members or others, or for distribution or division among its members or their guests, and will not maintain any unlawful drinking place or any liquor nuisance contrary to the laws of Alabama, and if it does so it is understood that its charter and rights as a corporation will be forfeited.

ARTICLE VII

The Citizens' Club shall not permit any game to be played for wager, or any gambling, or the presence of any gambling device on, or about the premises, or at the club room of the corporation, and if it does any of these things it agrees that its charter and rights as a corporation will be forfeited. The limitations herein contained shall not be construed so as to prohibit the playing of cards, dominoes, chess, pool, billiards, or other like amusements where nothing is wagered on such game.

ARTICLE VIII AMENDMENTS

This constitution may be amended at any regular or special meeting of this organization by a three fourths vote of those voting, provided the proposed amendment shall have been approved by the Board of Directors, a copy thereof posted on the bulletin board in the quarters of the club at least ten days prior to the time of voting, and a notice of said meeting mailed by the Secretary to each member at least ten days prior to the time of the voting.

BY-LAWS MEMBERSHIP

Section 1. Active membership in The Citizens' Club shall be obtained in the following manner: A candidate shall present a written application to the Board of Directors at least ten days prior to the time of voting upon his name, and said Board shall immediately cause an investigation to be made of said applicant. Notice of the candidate's application shall be mailed by the Secretary to each member of the

Board not less than ten days prior to the time of voting on said application, and at each regular meeting of the Board of Directors the name of all candidates for membership, whose names have been duly processed as required herein, shall be read and voted upon, and a $\frac{3}{4}$ vote shall be required before any such candidate is admitted to membership.

Section 2. Each member shall be required to pay a fee of \$1.00 upon joining said club and in addition annual dues of \$4.00 plus monthly dues of \$0.25 for membership.

Section 3. A member shall be dropped from the roll after being delinquent for one year.

OFFICERS

Section 4. The President shall be ex-officio member of all committees.

Section 5. The Secretary shall be a paid official who shall receive a salary to be determined by the Board of Directors. He shall conduct all official correspondence, preserve all records and communications, and record the proceedings of this organization, of the Board of Directors, and of all committees. He shall perform all duties assigned by the Board of Directors, shall act as an ex-officio member of all committees and shall appoint, dismiss, and supervise all employees. He must give bond, the amount of which the Directors shall determine.

THE BOARD OF DIRECTORS

Section 6. Within three days following the election of the Board of Directors, they shall elect from their own number a President, a first and second Vice President and a Treasurer. They shall also elect a Secretary who, upon election, automatically becomes a non-voting member of the Board and shall receive a salary to be fixed by the Board. The President of the organization shall serve as President of the Board of Directors. The Board of Directors shall have power to fill all vacancies on the Board, to adopt rules for the conduct of the business of the organization and to take any action necessary for the governing and direction of this organization or the control of its property. At the annual meeting the executive secretary shall submit a full report of all actions and decisions.

RESIGNATIONS

Section 7. Resignations shall be presented in writing to the Board of Directors. A resignation, however, shall not release the member from the dues for the fiscal year already entered upon.

EXPULSION

Section 8. Any member may be expelled by a two-thirds vote of the entire

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Board of Directors at a meeting called for this purpose, provided, the member shall have been notified of this proposed expulsion. He shall be allowed a personal hearing before the Board but not the right of representation by professional counsels.

COMMITTEES

Section 9. The President shall appoint all committees, subject to approval by the Board of Directors. An executive committee composed of five members shall transact all routine business, shall act for the Board in the interim between meetings, shall order disbursements for the necessary expenses, and shall fix the salaries for all appointive employees. He shall submit to the Board of Directors for confirmation reports of all of his actions.
