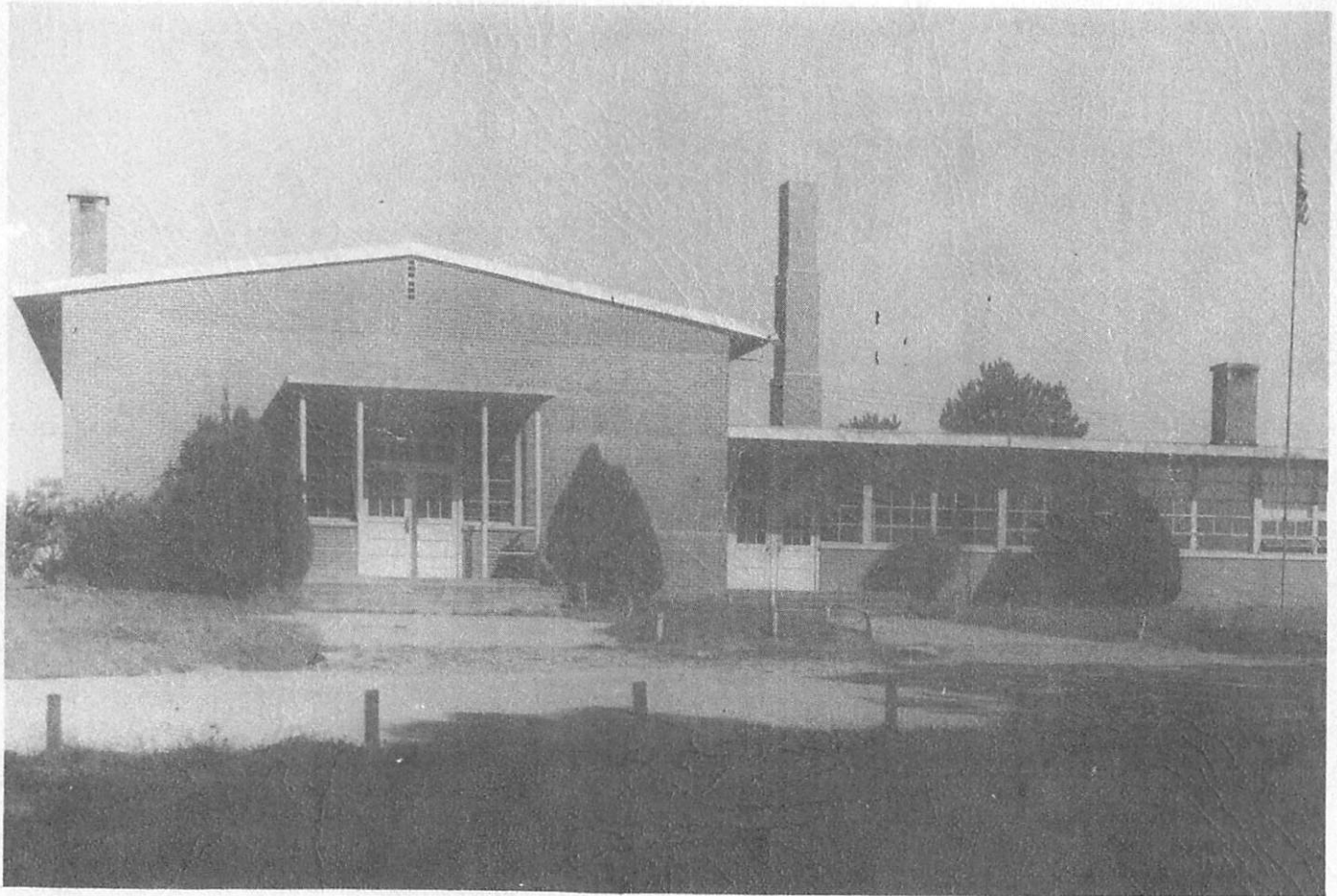

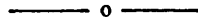

THE SUPERINTENDENT



Walter Tate McKee, Superintendent of Montgomery Schools was born at Newton, May, 7, 1909, to Mr. and Mrs. J. T. McKee. At the age of five the family moved to Florence.

In 1926 he finished the demonstration high school at Florence and two years later was graduated from the Normal College. After attending the University of Alabama for several summers, he received his Bachelor of Science Degree in Education in 1933; and Masters of Science Degree in school administration in 1936. Further study was done at Peabody College toward a Doctorate.

Mr. McKee's teaching experiences include his position at Chisholm (1928-29) where he taught science and coached junior high football. From 1929-31 he served as head of the Science Department at Capitol Heights Junior High School. For the next six years he served as Principal of the Pine Level School. From 1937-43 he was Principal of the Capitol Heights Junior High School.

On Jan. 1, 1943, he became assistant superintendent of Montgomery County Schools; in October, 1954, associate superintendent. In July, 1958, he became superintendent, succeeding the late Dr. Claronce M. Dannelly, who retired at that time.



ASSOCIATE SUPERINTENDENT

Mr. William S. Garrett became Assistant Superintendent of Montgomery City and County Public Schools in 1950, and has labored untiringly in bringing about greater opportunities for the girls and boys of the county.

On July 1, 1958, Mr. Garrett became Associate Superintendent succeeding Mr. Walter T. McKee, our present superintendent.

Mr. Garrett holds the A.B. Degree from Huntingdon College and the M.A. Degree from Duke University.



ASSISTANT SUPERINTENDENT

Mr. T. A. Kirby, Assistant Superintendent of Education holds the B.S. Degree from Jacksonville State College and the M.S. Degree from Auburn. He served as principal of Maxwell Elementary School for eight years and Captiol Heights for three years.

THE PRINCIPAL



In 1939, Mr. Richard Flowers was appointed as one of the three teachers at the Ramer Elementary School and served as the principal.

In 1947, after a tour of duty in the United States Army he was appointed principal of the school and has witnessed its growth from a three teachers' school to its present status of an elementary and high school with competent teaching personnel and adequate teaching facilities.

Prof. Flowers was born in the LeGrande community, ten miles from the Dunbar School, and received his elementary education at the Corner Elementary School, which is now known as the Phillips Elementary School. His high school, college and graduate work was done at the Alabama State College where he earned his B.S. and Masters of Education Degrees.

When interviewed, he stated that he had "been with the school from its infancy to its present state of maturity; and that today's celebration is a dream which has become a reality". He expresses thanks to the Board of Education for this new facility we now enjoy.

HISTORY OF DUNBAR HIGH SCHOOL

Ramer, Alabama

PHYSICAL GROWTH OF THE SCHOOL

The history of the local Dunbar High School, formerly Ramer High School, dates back to the year 1874 when the first school was opened in the Weeping Mary Methodist Church located in the Ramer community within the Ramer City Limits. It was made of logs and the first teacher was Mr. Charlie Johnson, a native of the Ramer community.

Three years later (1877) the Mt. Gillard Baptist Church (in the same community) was finally selected as the new site for conducting classes. The new teacher was Tom Steele. Classes were continually held at the Mt. Gillard Baptist Church under the tutelage of Professor White from 1888-1896; followed by Professor Nelson Edward Henry, Sr. The late Nelson Edward Henry, Sr., a native of Dallas County, graduated from the Normal Course at Tuskegee Institute in 1894. After serving for two years at Matthews Station in Bullock County, he came to Ramer, Alabama. He began teaching in the Mt. Gillard Baptist Church in 1896 and was instrumental in erecting the first school building at Ramer in 1897, where he remained until 1902.

The land on which the first building was erected was given by Mr. Louis Wilson of Montgomery, Alabama. This new school, the inspiration of the community was short lived having been burned completely. Classes were resumed in the Mt. Gillard Church. For the next 34 years (1902-1936) classes were held in the Church.

In 1936 the present elementary building was erected which was used for teaching the first six grades. There was no high school in this vicinity. Students had to attend private high schools; as there were no public school in Montgomery County for Negroes.

Eleven years later 1936-1947 four grades were added, giving Ramer its first high school. The principals: Mr. Richard Flowers, 1939-41; Prof. James Lott, 1941-42; and Mrs. Geraldine Bell, 1942-1947. In 1947, Prof. Richard Flowers returned as principal and remains to the present. The three (3) room frame building housed eight (8) grades and three (3) teachers. The Masonic Lodge housed the first grade and Mt. Gillard Church housed the seventh grade. There were seven teachers and ten grades. Thereafter, one grade per year was added until there was a Senior High School.

In 1948 high school classes were removed from the frame building, and the church and occupied the newly erected four room plus auditorium brick building. In 1949, six classrooms including the library, indoor toilets and a supply room were added.

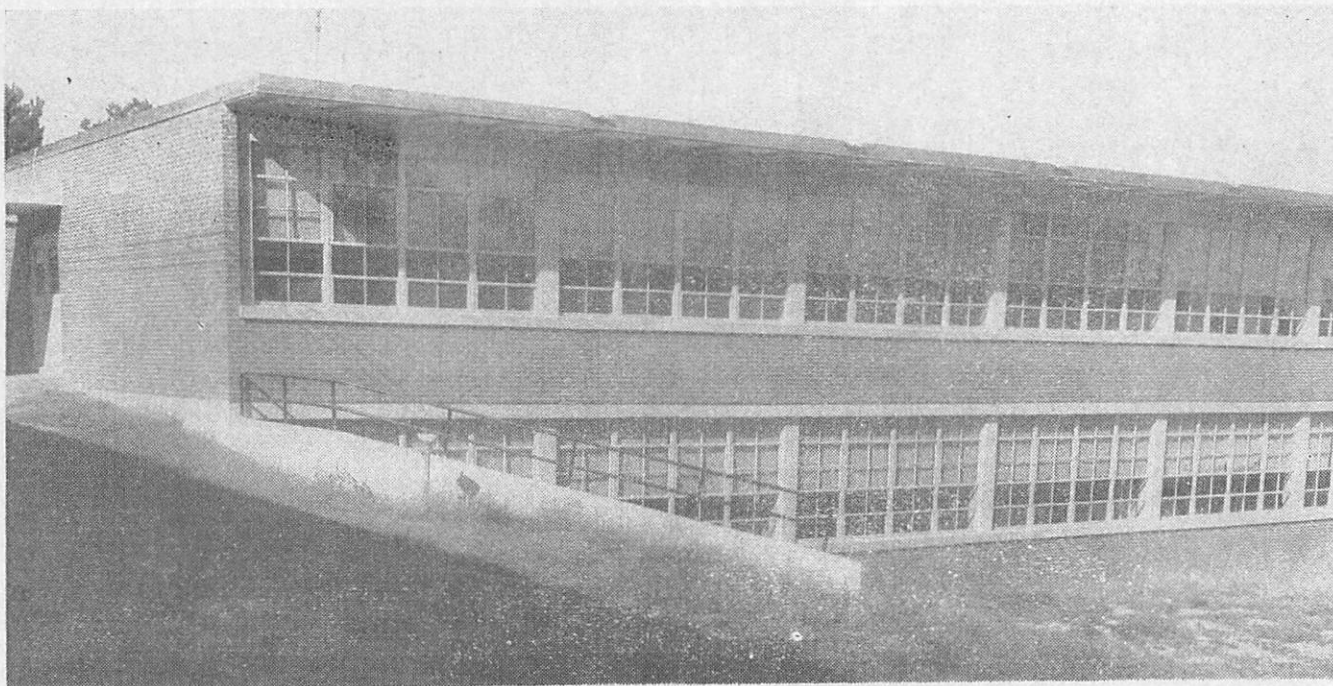
In 1951 the Department of Physical Education officially came into its own. In 1959 the Department of Home Making and Industrial Arts were added; thus preparing students to more efficiently become homemakers and handymen. In 1961 a band program was initiated.

In June of 1963, ten classrooms and a gymnasium were added, thus giving adequate facility for the 739 students enrolled. The personnel has increased to twenty-five (25) teachers, a full time secretary, two cooks and one full time maid and janitor. To meet the needs of transportation we now have twelve buses; thus making it possible for a greater portion of our pupils to attend classes daily.

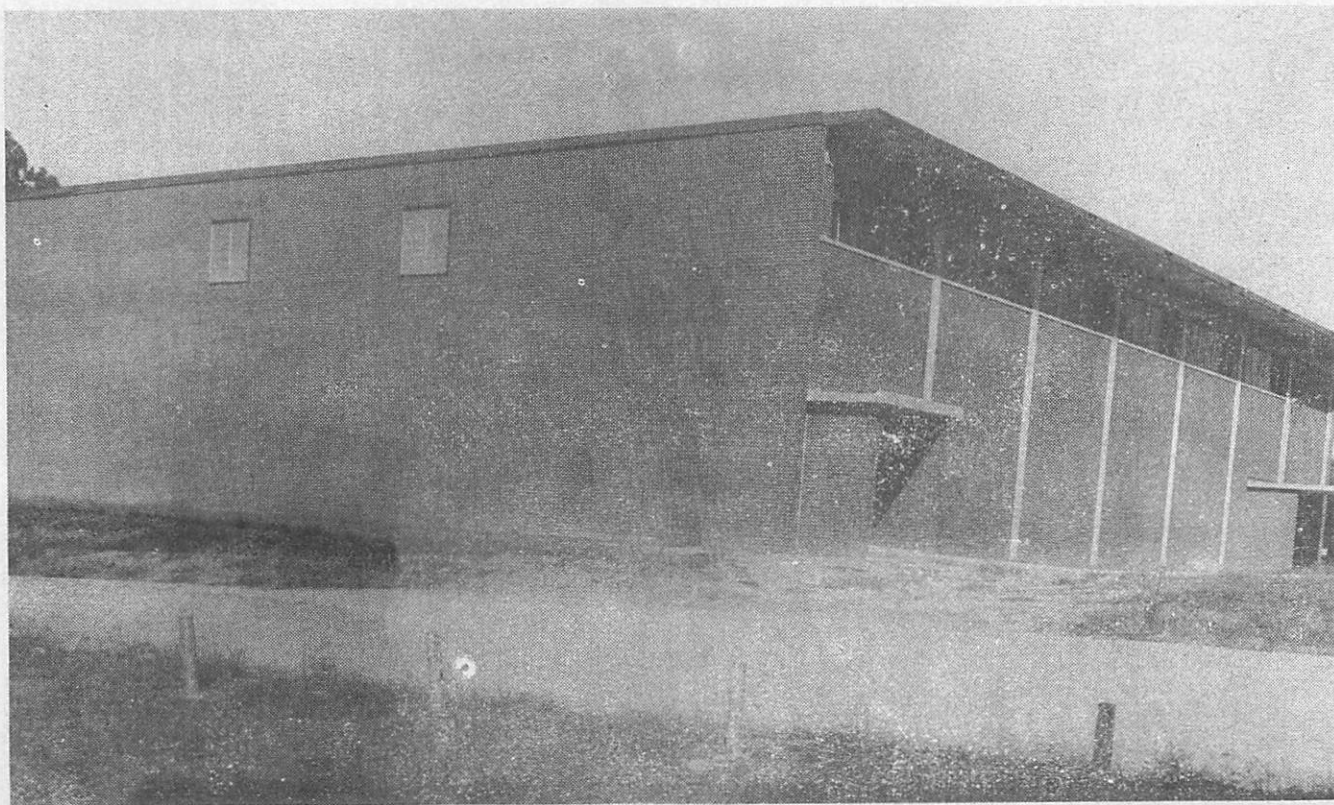
Dunbar is proud of the progress made thus far. We look forward to a brighter future, we know that the added facility will enable us to render greater service to the communities served by Dunbar.

The school serves as a beacon to its community, sincere hopes are expressed for its continuance service to the boys and girls of Montgomery County for many years to come.
